A Bill respecting the Calgary Chinese Public School Society

No. 36 of 1964

An Act respecting the Calgary
Chinese Public School Society

(Assented to _____, 1964)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Calgary Chinese Public School Society is a Society incorporated under the laws of the Province of Alberta whose object is to own and operate a Public School for Chinese students in the City of Calgary;

AND WHEREAS the said Society now owns and operates a Public School in the City of Calgary called The Calgary Chinese Public School situate at 125 - 2nd Avenue S.W., the legal description of which land is that portion of Lot Thirty-two (32) which lies to the West of the Easterly Twelve (12) Feet of the said Lot Thirty-two (32) and all of Lot Thirty-three (33), in Block Four (4) as shown on Plan C. Calgary;

AND WHEREAS the said Society receives no grant or monies of any kind from any government or other public source and is entirely dependant for its capital and operating expenses upon charitable donations from the Chinese Community of Calgary;

AND WHEREAS a Petition has been presented by The Calgary Chinese Public School Society praying for exemption from taxation with respect to the said real property owned and operated by it as a Public School;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Calgary Chinese Public School Society Relief from Taxation Act*".

Exemption
from
taxation

2. As, from and after the thirty-first day of December, 1963, all the real property owned by The Calgary Chinese Public School Society at 126 - 2nd Avenue S.W. Calgary, the legal description of which land is that portion of Lot Thirty-two (32) which lies to the West of the Easterly Twelve (12) Feet of the said Lot Thirty-two (32) and all of Lot Thirty-three (33) in Block Four (4) as shown on Plan C, Calgary, is exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals, so long as the said real property is being used for school and educational purposes.

Commence-
ment of Act

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
