Preamble

WHEREAS The Christian Training Institute, North American Baptists, Edmonton, Alberta, has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to The Christian Training Institute, North American Baptists, from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. The property located at Edmonton, Alberta, described as follows, namely:

Lots 24-30, in Block 174, Subdivision RL 9, in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, according to a Plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan 4400 R.

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as it shall remain registered in the name of The Christian Training Institute, North American Baptists, and owned by it and used by it for or in connection with educational purposes.

Commencement of Act 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
