Preamble

WHEREAS the Congregation of the Brothers of Our Lady of Lourdes, Calgary, Alberta, has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to the Don Bosco House from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The property located at Calgary, Alberta, described as follows, namely:

Lots Thirty (30), Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32), Block 6, Plan B 1 Mission, Calgary,
shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as it shall remain registered in the name of the Congregation of the Brothers of Our Lady of Lourdes and owned by it and used by it for or in connection with educational purposes.

Commence-
ment of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
