An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Land which is Operated by The Edmonton Home for Ex-Servicemen's Children, Edmonton, Alberta, from Assessment and Taxation

(Assented to _____, 1964)

Preamble

WHEREAS The Edmonton Home for Ex-Servicemen's Children, Edmonton, Alberta, has presented a petition, praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain properties operated by The Edmonton Home for Ex-Servicemen's Children from assessment and taxation, other than that relating to local improvements, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioner;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. The land on which is located The Edmonton Home for Ex-Servicemen's Children at Edmonton, Alberta, namely;

Lots Ninety to Ninety-three, (90 to 93) inclusive, in Block Three (3), in the City of Edmonton, Province of Alberta, as shown on subdivision plan "B" (H.B. Reserve)

together with buildings located thereon, shall be exempt from assessment and taxation, except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals, so long as the said properties shall remain registered in the name of NATIONAL TRUST as TRUSTEES for the EDMONTON HOME for Ex-Servicemen's Children and operated by it, and used by it, for the care of orphaned or distressed children.

Commencement of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1964.
