Explanatory Note

1. The Treasury Department Act, R.S.A. 1955, chapter 343, amended.

2. Section 59, subsection (1) presently reads:

"59. (1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council

(a) when he deems it conducive to the public good, and

(a) when he deems it conducive to the public good, and
(b) when great public inconvenience or great hardship and injustice to any person would otherwise ensue,
may remit any tax or fee payable to Her Majesty and imposed or authorized by and relating to any matter within the authority of the Legislative Assembly or any forfeiture or pecuniary penalty so imposed for any contravention of the laws relating to the revenue or to the management of any public work producing revenue, although any part of such forfeiture or penalty be given by law to the informer or prosecutor or to any other party.".

Section 59, subsection (1) has remained in the same form since it was first enacted in 1906. It is recast here primarily to clarify the instances where remissions may be granted.

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Treasury Department Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 59 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:

59. (1) Where the Lieutenant Governor in Council considers it in the public interest to do so or considers it advisable to do so in cases where injustice or great hardship to any person has resulted or is likely to result, he may order the remission of

- (a) any tax, fee or other sum paid or payable to Her Majesty in right of Alberta and imposed or authorized under an Act of the Province, and
- (b) any pecuniary penalty, fine or forfeiture imposed under any law in force in the Province, notwithstanding that the whole or part of it is paid or payable to the informer, prosecutor or any other person.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
