(Assented to _____, 1964)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Young Men's Christian Association has presented a Petition for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands and buildings belonging to the Association from assessment and taxation, other than that relating to local improvements, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition.

THEREFORE Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. Each of the following lands and buildings in the City of Edmonton which are owned by the Young Men's Christian Association and used for Central Y.M.C.A., West Edmonton Y.M.C.A. and the South Edmonton Y.M.C.A. and described as follows:

Central Y.M.C.A., buildings and land, Lots Seventy-seven (77) and Seventy-eight (78), River Lot Six (6), Plan F.

South Edmonton Y.M.C.A., buildings and land, Lots Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31), Block Eleven (11), Plan 1286 K.S.

West Edmonton Y.M.C.A., buildings only, located on lands leased from the City of Edmonton, being South 200 feet of Lot A, Block Two (2), Plan 3010 P, and South 200 feet of Block 3, Plan XXIV A in Glenora, Edmonton, shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals, so long as it continues to belong to the Young Men's Christian Association and is used for its purposes.

Commence-
ment of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
