Preamble

WHEREAS Bow Valley Lodges Foundation, Calgary, Alberta, has presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to Bow Valley Lodges Foundation from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The property located at Calgary, Alberta, described as follows, namely:

Block A, exempting thereout the Easterly ten (10) feet thereof in perpendicular width, according to a plan of part of the City of Calgary of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as Calgary 4897 H.E.

Reserving unto Her Majesty Her Successors and Assigns all mines and minerals and the right to work the same,

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements so long as it shall remain registered in the name of Bow Valley Lodges Foundation and used for or in connection with residences for senior citizens.
