A Bill to amend The National Centennial Act (Alberta)

HON. MR. HOLOWACH

Explanatory Note

1. General. Parliament recently changed the name of the National Centennial Act to the Centennial of Canadian Confederation Act and the name of the National Centennial Administration to the Centennial Commission. The National Centennial Act (Alberta), Statutes of Alberta, 1962, c. 56, is amended to make its terminology more uniform with the federal Act.

An Act to amend The National Centennial Act (Alberta)

(Assented to _____, 1964)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The National Centennial Act (Alberta)* is hereby amended.

2. Section 1 is amended by striking out the words "*The National Centennial Act (Alberta)*" and by substituting the words "*The Centennial of Canadian Confederation Act (Alberta)*".

3. Section 2, clause (a) is amended by striking out the words "National Centennial Committee (Alberta)" and by substituting the words "Alberta Centennial Committee".

4. Section 3, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the words "National Centennial Committee (Alberta)" and by substituting the words "Alberta Centennial Committee".

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
