1. The Public Health Act, R.S.A. 1955, chapter 255, amended.

2. Section 4 presently reads:

"4. In the absence of the chairman from any meeting the Provincial Board shall appoint one of its members present to act as chairman during the meeting, and the acting chairman shall perform all duties of the chairman under this Act.".

3. Section 14a, which authorizes the fluoridation of a communal water supply subject to a plebiscite of the electors of the municipality is amended to provide a means whereby a portion of a municipality with a separate water supply, such as a hamlet, can decide on fluoridation without reference to electors of other parts of the municipality who are not served or affected by the water supply.

4. The present section 19 (1) revised to include reference to a new town, county or municipal district.

5. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Public Health Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Public Health Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended

- (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1),
- (b) by adding the following subsection after the renumbered subsection (1):

(2) Any order, instrument or other document made or issued under this Act or the regulations or any other Act or regulations thereunder and that may be or is required to be made or signed by the chairman may be signed by any member of the Provincial Board in the absence of the chairman.

3. Section 14*a* is amended by adding the following subsection:

(8) Where a communal water supply supplies water to only a portion of the municipality, the municipality may by by-law provide authority for the fluoridation of that communal water supply and in such case this section applies thereto as though the words "the municipality" in subsections (3) and (4) read "that portion of the municipality served by the water supply".

4. Section 19 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:

19. (1) In this section and sections 20 and 21, "municipality" means a city, town, new town, village, county or municipal district.

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
