A Bill to amend The Gas Utilities Act

HON. MR. MANNING

Explanatory Note

1. The Gas Utilities Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1960, c. 37, amended.

2. Section 49a, subsection (2) presently reads:

"(2) The Gas Utilities Board shall elect a chairman from among its members."

3. Section 49c presently reads:

"49c. Where an application for a permit for a pipe line for the transmission of gas is made under section 5 of The Pipe Line Act, 1958, the Oil and Gas Conservation Board may refer the application to the Gas Utilities Board and the Gas Utilities Board may consider the application with respect to the public interest and may recommend to the Minister of Mines and Minerals that the permit be granted or refused."

See the Bill containing the proposed amendments to The Pipe Line Act, 1958, whereby referrals of applications for gas pipe line permits to the Gas Utilities Board will now be made by the Minister of Mines and Minerals rather than by the Oil and Gas Conservation Board under the present section 49c of this Act.

An Act to amend The Gas Utilities Act

(Assented to _____, 1964)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Gas Utilities Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 49a is amended by striking out subsection (2) and by substituting the following:
 - (2) The member appointed pursuant to clause (c) of subsection (1) shall be chairman of the Gas Utilities Board.
3. Section 49c is repealed.
4. This Act comes into force on the first day of June, 1964.
