BILL 117

A Bill to amend The Drainage Districts Act

HON. MR. STROM

Explanatory Note

1. The Drainage Districts Act, R.S.A. 1955, chapter 91, amended.

2. Section 169 presently reads:

"169. (1) If any rates remain unpaid after the thirty-first day of December of the year for which they are levied, there shall be added thereto by way of a penalty a sum equal to two percent of the amount of the rates that at that date are unpaid.

(2) If any rates remain unpaid after the last day of March next following, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty an additional sum equal to two per cent of the rates that at that date remain unpaid.

(3) If any rates remain unpaid after the last day of June next following, there shall be added thereto by way of a penalty an additional sum equal to four per cent of the rates that at that date remain unpaid.

(4) In each succeeding year there shall be added at the same times penalties computed in the same manner.

(5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to extend the time for payment of the rates, or in any way to impair the right of distress or any other remedy provided by this Act for the collection of the rates.

(6) When a penalty is added under this section it shall be computed as a percentage of the sum of the arrears of rates and of the penalties, if any, already added."

An Act to amend The Drainage Districts Act

(Assented to _____, 1964)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Drainage Districts Act* is hereby amended.

2. Section 169 is struck out and the following is substituted:

169. (1) The board by by-law may provide that if after the last day of February in any year rates that became due and payable in the preceding year remain unpaid, a penalty of an amount not exceeding six per cent of the unpaid rates be added thereto on the first day of March of that year and of each succeeding year so long as the rates remain unpaid.

(2) The penalty becomes part of the arrears of rates.

(3) Nothing in this section extends the time for payment of the rates or impairs the right to enforce any remedy provided by this Act for the recovery of rates.

3. This Act comes into force on the thirty-first day of December, 1964.
