An Act to Incorporate the Cardinal Savings & Trust Company

(Assented to _____, 1965)

Preamble	<p>WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their Petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:</p> <p>NOW THEREFORE Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:</p>
Short title	<p>1. This Act may be cited as "<i>The Cardinal Savings & Trust Company Act</i>".</p>
Incorporation	<p>2. Norman E. Hames, Chartered Accountant; John E. Collins, Chartered Accountant; Robert J. Howell, Chartered Accountant; James P. French, Chartered Accountant and Lief Erickson, Chartered Accountant; all of 505 8th Avenue, S.W. Calgary, Alberta, together with such persons as become shareholders in the Company, are incorporated under the name of Cardinal Savings & Trust Company, hereinafter called "the Company".</p>
Provisional directors	<p>3. The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company.</p>
Capital stock	<p>4. The capital stock of the Company shall be two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, divided into twenty-five thousand shares of ten dollars each.</p>
Head office	<p>5. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta.</p>
Powers	<p>6. The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of <i>The Trust Companies Act, 1960</i>.</p>
Commencement of Act	<p>7. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.</p>
