Preamble

WHEREAS the Red Deer Association for Retarded Children has presented a petition praying for An Act to provide for the exemption of certain land owned by the Red Deer Association for Retarded Children or held in trust for its benefit, from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. The following property situated in the Province of Alberta, described as follows:

Lot (J), containing one and fourty-four hundredths (1.44) acres, more or less, in the City of Red Deer in the Province of Alberta, Canada, as shown on sub-division plan 3962 H.W. ($E\frac{1}{2}$ 21-38-27-W4)

shall be exempt from assessment and taxation other than taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals so long as it shall remain registered in the name of the Red Deer Association for Retarded Children and owned by it or held in trust for it and used by it for or in educating retarded children.

Commencement of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
