### No. 9 of 1965

#### An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Land which is the Property of Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate from Assessment and Taxation

Preamble

WHEREAS a petition has been presented for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain land belonging to Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate, a body corporate incorporated under 4, George VI, Chapter 54 (1940) from assessment and taxation other than that relating to local improvements and mines and minerals and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation **1.** The property located in the City of Edmonton, Alberta, and described as follows, namely:

All that portion of Lot Twelve (12) in Block Five (5) in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, as shown on Subdivision Plan 6061 M.C., which lies between the North boundary of the said lot and a line drawn parallel thereto and Two Hundred and Fortyeight and Thirty-three Hundredths (248.33) feet perpendicularly distant southerly therefrom containing Two and Forty-three Hundredths (2.43) acres more or less (Duggan S.E. 17 R-52-24-W.4)

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

together with the buildings located thereon shall be exempt from assessment and taxation, except for taxes relating to local improvements and taxes pertaining to minerals, so long as the same is owned by Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate and used by it for religious, spiritual, educational and welfare purposes.

Commencement of Act 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1965. No. 9
