An Act to Provide for the Exemption of Certain Lands belonging to The Community, General Hospital, Alms House and Seminary of Learning of the Sisters of Charity at Ottawa, Canada, from Assessment and Taxation

Preamble

WHEREAS The Community General Hospital, Alms House and Seminary of Learning of the Sisters of Charity at Ottawa, Canada, being a body corporate incorporated by Chapter 71, 25-26, George V (1935) has presented a petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain lands belonging to The Community, General Hospital, Alms House and Seminary of Learning of the Sisters of Charity at Ottawa, Canada, located in the Town of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta, from assessment and taxation, other than taxes relating to local improvements and minerals, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption
from
taxation

1. The following properties, namely,

All that portion of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Seventy-eight (78), Range Six (6), West of the Sixth (6th) Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Dominion of Canada, bounded as follows:

On the North by the South limit of Fourth Avenue as shown on Subdivision Plan 4880 H.W. On the South by the North limit of Fifth Avenue, as shown on Subdivision Plan 6498 K.S. On the West by the East limit of Moore Street, as shown on the said Plan 6498 K.S. and on the East by a line drawn parallel to the West limit of Holden Street, as shown on Subdivision Plan 1970 B.P. and Six Hundred (600) feet perpendicularly distant westerly therefrom.

The land hereby described containing forty-two hundredths (0.42) of an acre more or less.

Reserving unto Her Majesty all mines and minerals together with buildings located thereon shall be exempt from

assessment and taxation, except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals, so long as the same is owned by The Community, General Hospital, Alms House and Seminary of Learning of the Sisters of Charity at Ottawa, Canada and used by it for religious, spiritual, educational and welfare purposes.

Commence-
ment of Act

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1965.
