Preamble

WHEREAS La Corporation des Soeurs de Sainte Croix et Des Sept Douleurs, being a body corporate incorporated by chapter 116 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, have presented a Petition praying for an Act to provide for the exemption of certain land belonging to La Corporation des Soeurs de Sainte Croix et des Sept Douleurs, from assessment and taxation, other than that relating to local improvements and mines and minerals, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner:

THEREFORE Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Change of name

1. Chapter 116 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, being An Act to Incorporate La Corporation des Soeurs de Sainte Croix et des Sept Douleurs, is hereby amended.

Amends s. 1 2. Section 1 is amended by striking out the words "La Corporation des Soeurs de Sainte Croix et des Sept Douleurs" and by substituting the words "La Corporation Des Soeurs de Sainte Croix et des Sept Douleurs and/or The Sisters of the Holy Cross".

New section 15a

3. The Act is further amended by adding the following new section after section 15:

Exemption from taxation

15a. The following land, namely,

Lot Two (2) in Block Eight (8) in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, as shown on Subdivision Plan 3195 M.C. (Bonnie Doon S.E. 28-52-24-W.4)

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals and

Lots Eighteen (18) and Nineteen (19) in Block One Hundred and Sixty-three (163) in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, Dominion of Canada. as shown on Subdivision Plan 1-23-A. Excepting thereout the Southerly Fifty-one (51) feet throughout of said Lots Eighteen (18) and Nineteen (19).

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals, together with the buildings located thereon shall be exempt from assessment and taxation except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals for so long as the same are owned and used by the corporation for or in connection with the provision and facilities for divine worship, charitable purposes and the provision of educational and training facilities for young girls and young ladies seeking to devote their lives to the Sisterhood.

Commencement of Act 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1965.
