No. 19 of 1965

An Act to Incorporate Rocky Mountain Life Insurance Company

(Assented to _____, 1965)

Preamble

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their Petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition:

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Incorporation

1. James E. Wood, Life Underwriter, John Ewens, Chartered Accountant, Robert S. Dinkel, Barrister and Solicitor, all of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, and Harvey A. Reist, Medical Doctor of Daysland, in the Province of Alberta, and Raymond J. Hannigan, Businessman, of the City of Red Deer, in the Province of Alberta, and Harris S. Wood, Dentist, of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, together with such persons as become shareholders in the Company, are incorporated under the name of Rocky Mountain Life Insurance Company, hereinafter called "the Company".

Directors

2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be the provisional directors of the Company.

Capital stock

3. (1) The capital stock of the Company shall be two million, five hundred thousand dollars, which may be increased to five million dollars.

(2) The capital stock of the Company shall be divided into shares of a par value of ten dollars each.

Subscription

4. The amount to be subscribed before the general meeting for the election of directors is called shall be five hundred thousand dollars.

Commencement of business

5. The Company shall not commence business unless the amount of capital stock required by section 34 of *The Alberta Insurance Act* has been subscribed and paid.

Head office

6. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta.

Contracts

7. The Company is hereby empowered to carry on and engage in the business of participating and non-participating life insurance in all its usual requisite and incidental forms including, but not so as to restrict the generality of the foregoing, whole life, limited pay life, endowment, term, annuities, double indemnity, income disability, waiver disability, guaranteed insurability option, reinsurance, group life, group sickness and accident, group double indemnity, group weekly indemnity, group monthly indemnity, income replacement, group pension, group dental, group hospitalization, group comprehensive and group major medical.

The Companies Act

8. Sections 62 to 67 of *The Companies Act* apply to the Company.

The Alberta Insurance Act

9. *The Alberta Insurance Act* applies to the Company.

Short title

10. This Act may be cited as "*The Rocky Mountain Life Insurance Company Act*".

Commencement of Act

11. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
