1. This Bill amends The Mewata Park Enabling Act (1956, c. 31) to enable the City of Calgary to make certain uses of Mewata Park. The park is held by the City under a grant that restricts its use to the purposes of a public park. The 1956 Act enabled the City to use the park for certain other specified uses.

2. A by-law providing for the use of part of the park for the purposes mentioned in clause 1 is validated.

3. Commencement of Act.

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Mewata Park Enabling Act is amended as to section 2 by adding after clause (d) the following clauses:

- (e) the erection of a planetarium;
- (f) the erection of a hall of natural science;
- (g) the erection of any other building that is approved pursuant to Acts of Canada and the Province as a project in connection with the celebration of the Centennial of Confederation in Canada.

2. By-law No. 6359 of the City of Calgary passed on the twentieth day of July, 1964 is hereby validated and confirmed.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
