A Bill to amend The Livestock Diseases Act

HON. MR. STROM

Explanatory Note

1. Section 2, clause (k) presently reads:

(k) "vaccinated" means vaccinated with brucella abortus strain 19 vaccine, between the ages of four months and eleven months or four month and such older age as may be permitted by the regulations and covered by a vaccination certificate or tattoo.

Change in age of vaccination in accordance with federal-provincial policy across Canada.

2. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Livestock Diseases Act

(Assented to _____, 1965)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Livestock Diseases Act* is amended as to section 2 by striking out clause (k) and by substituting the following:

(k) "vaccinated" means vaccinated with brucella abortus strain 19 vaccine, between the ages of 120 days and 270 days, or such other age as may be permitted by regulation and covered by a vaccination certificate or tattoo.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
