Explanatory Note

General. The Agreement mentioned in this Bill provides that the northern most 200 feet of the property being sold is not to be used for graves but may be used for a mausoleum.

The property of the Strathcona Cemetery Company was acquired by the City of Edmonton in 1941, and part of it is still used as the Mount Pleasant Cemetery. This Bill would enable the use of the affected land for graves.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Agreement made the sixth of November, 1914 between Margaret Martin of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta and the Strathcona Cemetery Company for the sale of certain land described therein is, to the extent that it restricts or regulates the use that may be made of part of that land, hereby abrogated and the Registrar of Land Titles for the North Alberta Land Registration District shall forthwith discharge the caveat registered as No. 6307 against Block 7A in the City of Edmonton as shown on Subdivision Plan 6681MC (Martin Estate N.W. 17-52-24-W.4).
- 2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
