A Bill to amend The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act

Explanatory Note

- 1. The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act, R.S.A. 1955, chapter 292, amended.
 - 2. Section 3, subsection (4) presently reads:
 - (4) An order made pursuant to this section takes effect as and from the making of the order.
- 3. Under section 12, subsection (2), a shareholder who does not become a subscriber of the company's system has certain of his rights suspended. The amendment in subsection (3) is made to conform with subsection (2).
 - 4. Section 20, subsection (1) presently reads:
 - 20. (1) The authorized capital of a company shall be
 - (a) a sum equivalent to two hundred and twenty-five dollars for each mile of pole line of the system of the company, or
 - (b) such greater sum as may be fixed by the Minister.
 - 5. Section 21, subsection (2) presently reads:
 - (2) No one share shall be
 - (a) issued to more than one person, or
 - (b) registered in the name of more than one person except only in the case where the share has devolved upon the personal representative of a deceased or mentally incompetent shareholder or the assignee in bankruptcy of a shareholder.
 - 6. Commencement of Act.

- HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- 1. The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 3, subsection (4) is amended by striking out the word "making" and by substituting the word "date".
- 3. Section 12, subsection (3) is amended by striking out the words "suspension of a shareholder" and by substituting the words "suspension of the rights of a shareholder".
- 4. Section 20 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:
- 20. (1) The authorized capital of the company shall be a sum equivalent to the value of the company's assets as determined by the Minister.
- **5.** Section 21, subsection (2), clause (a) is amended by striking out the word "issued" and by substituting the word "allotted".
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
