A Bill to amend The Election Act

Explanatory Note

1. This Bill amends chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956.

2. Section 16, clause (b) reads:

16. The following persons are disqualified to be registered as electors and shall not vote:

(b) a person, wholly or partly of Indian blood and ordinarily resident on an Indian reservation, who is entitled to receive any annuity or other benefit under any treaty with the Crown in the right of Canada, unless he was a member of Her Majesty's Forces during World War I or World War II, or was a member of the Canadian Forces who served on active service subsequent to the ninth day of September, 1950;

3. Form 31 is a form of oath to be taken by a voter whose name is not on the voters' list and Form 33 is a form of oath to be taken by election officials.

4. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Election Act

(Assented to _____, 1965)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Election Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 16 is amended by striking out clause (b).
3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended
 - (a) as to paragraph 1 of Form 31 by striking out the words "that you are not an Indian within the meaning of *The Election Act*,"
 - (b) as to paragraph 2 of Form 33 by striking out the words "that you are not an Indian within the meaning of *The Election Act*,".
4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
