BILL 97

A Bill to amend The Mineral Taxation Act

HON. MR. PATRICK

Explanatory Note

1. This Bill amends The Mineral Taxation Act, which is chapter 203 of the Revised Statutes.

2. Section 2, clause (f), subclause (ii) presently reads:

2. In this Act,

.....

(f) "mineral"

.....

(ii) does not include sand and gravel that belong to the owner of the surface of land by virtue of The Sand and Gravel Act;

3. Approval of unit operation by the Oil and Gas Conservation Board no longer required.

Subsection (2) of section 10 presently reads:

(2) If the unit operation is for the purpose of producing petroleum or natural gas, the agreement, order or other document shall be accompanied by a duplicate of the order or direction of the Oil and Gas Conservation Board, appointed under The Oil and Gas Conservation Act, approving the unit operation.

4. Commencement of Act.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Mineral Taxation Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 2, clause (f) is amended by striking out sub-clause (ii) and by substituting the following:
 - (ii) does not include
 - (A) sand and gravel that belong to the owner of the surface of land under *The Sand and Gravel Act*, or
 - (B) clay and marl that belong to the owner of the surface of land under *The Clay and Marl Act*;
3. Section 10 is amended by striking out subsection (2).
4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
