Explanatory Note

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948.
- 2. Section 2, clause (f) presently reads:
 - 2. The Corporation shall have the following purposes and objects, that is to say:
 - (f) to do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, including the acquisition, by purchase or otherwise, and holding of real property and the alienation of the same at pleasure.

An Act to amend The Associated Hospitals of Alberta Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Associated Hospitals of Alberta Act is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (f) and by substituting the following:
 - (f) to acquire by purchase or otherwise, and to hold real property and to alienate the same at pleasure;
 - (g) to do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects and to represent any or all member hospitals in collective bargaining with hospital employees, organizations representing hospital employees and trade unions.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
