Explanatory Note

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 174 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2. Section 12, clause (t) presently reads:

12. Nothing in this Act renders any person ineligible to be nominated for or elected as a member of the Legislative Assembly or disqualifies him from sitting or voting in the Legislative Assembly, by reason only of the person

 (t) receiving or having agreed to receive, as a properly qualified member of the legal profession, fees for representing any person before any court as counsel assigned by a court, or

The provision is re-enacted to include cases where a member of the Assembly acts as legal counsel under the Legal Aid Plan presently being operated by the legal profession in co-operation with the Government.

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Legislative Assembly Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 12 is amended by striking out clause (t) and by substituting the following:

(t) receiving or having agreed to receive, in his capacity as a barrister and solicitor, fees for acting as legal counsel to any person in any civil or criminal proceedings, where he is appointed as counsel by a court or under a plan to provide legal aid that is financed wholly or partly by public funds, or

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
