A Bill to amend The Expropriation Procedure Act

#### **Explanatory Note**

1. This Bill amends chapter 30 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1961.

2. Section 36 is in Part III dealing with expropriation by companies. At present, it is common practice to issue interim orders under section 36 upon the company making a security deposit with the Public Utilities Board. The money is not payable, however, until the final order is made declaring the compensation for the interest in land and incidental damages. The new subsection (2a) will permit payment of an advance on the compensator from the moneys already on deposit.

3. Commencement of Act.

**H**<sup>ER</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Expropriation Procedure Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 36 is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (2):

(2a) The Board may on behalf of the company pay to any person having an estate or interest in the land affected by an order under subsection (1) the whole or any part of the amount deposited under this section and any payment so made shall be on account of such sums as the Board may subsequently order to be paid to that person pursuant to section 35.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
