An Act for Granting to Her Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respecively the Thirty-first Day of March, 1965, the Thirty-first Day of March, 1966, and the Thirty-first Day of March, 1967

#### (Assented to , 1966)

#### Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, J. W. Grant MacEwan, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively, the Thirty-first Day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-five, the Thirtyfirst Day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-six, and the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-seven, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1966".

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole. Three Hundred and Eighty-three Thousand Four Hundred Dollars towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-four, to the Thirtyfirst Day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-five, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "A" to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, Twenty-one Million Nine Hundred and Ninety-nine Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy-nine Dollars and Sixtythree Cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First Day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-five to the Thirtyfirst day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-six not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule "B" to this Act.

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding Six Hundred and Sixty-eight Million and Twenty-five Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eleven Dollars towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-six to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty-seven, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in Schedule "C" to this Act.

5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
