BILL 9

A Bill to amend The Jury Act

HON. MR. MANNING

Explanatory Note

1. This Bill amends chapter 165 of the Revised Statutes.

2. Section 2, clause (f) presently reads:

- (f) "sheriff"
 - (i) means the sheriff of the judicial district in which the Court is sitting, and
 - (ii) includes
 - (A) the assistant sheriff of such district,
 - (B) deputy sheriffs of sub-judicial districts, and
 - (C) in the case of the death, resignation or removal of a sheriff in a judicial district in which there is no assistant sheriff, or of a deputy sheriff, the Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Court for the judicial district or sub-judicial district, as the case may be, who for the time being is ex officio filling the office of sheriff or deputy sheriff.

This amendment removes the reference to "sub-judicial district" which has now been removed from existence. It also gives an area of authority to deputy sheriffs, who lost what authority they had when sub-judicial districts were removed.

3. Commencement of Act.

An Act to amend The Jury Act

(Assented to _____, 1966)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Jury Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 2, clause (f) is amended by striking out sub-clause (ii) and by substituting the following:
 - (ii) includes
 - (A) the assistant sheriff or a deputy sheriff, if any, of such district, and
 - (B) in the case of the death, resignation or removal of a sheriff in a judicial district in which there is no assistant sheriff or deputy sheriff, the Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Court for the judicial district, who for the time being is *ex officio* filling the office of sheriff or deputy sheriff.
3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
