An Act respecting the Department of Youth

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Department of Youth Act".
- 2. There shall be a department of the public service of the Province called the Department of Youth over which shall preside the member of the Executive Council appointed by the Lieutenant Governor under the Great Seal of the Province as the Minister of Youth.
- 3. Subject to *The Public Service Act, 1962*, there may be appointed a Deputy Minister of Youth and such other employees as are required for the proper conduct of the business of the Department of Youth.
 - 4. The Minister of Youth shall
 - (a) administer those Acts the administration of which is charged to the Minister of Youth,
 - (b) initiate, foster and encourage orderly development of all forms of constructive youth activities,
 - (c) stimulate interest and participation in youth training for leadership in all spheres of social, recreational, cultural and business affairs,
 - (d) encourage and promote activities to enable the maximum number of young people to actively participate in all forms of constructive sport, providing special assistance where warranted,
 - (e) promote interest and participation in physical fitness programs by groups, organizations and individuals.
 - (f) work in co-operation with other departments concerned with youth activities, co-ordinating programs desirable to carry out the intent and purpose of the Act.
 - (g) promote or attend any conferences or seminars in carrying out the duties under this Act, and

5. Annual report to the Legislative Assembly.

6. Commencement of Act.

- (h) perform such other functions as may be assigned by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
- 5. In each year the Minister of Youth shall cause to be prepared a report of the work of his Department for the preceding year and when prepared, shall lay a copy of it before the Legislative Assembly if it is then in session and if not, within fifteen days after the commencement of the next ensuing session.
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
