A Bill respecting the Establishment and Operation of
Mount Royal Junior College

HON. MR. MCKINNON

Explanatory Note

This Bill will provide the machinery for the establishment of a public junior college in Calgary to take over the facilities and operations of Mount Royal College—a private junior college which was incorporated by private Bill in 1910. The name of this corporation is being changed to George W. Kerby College at this session by Private Bill No. Pr. 4.

2. Calgary school districts may establish Mount Royal Junior College.

3. Agreement to take over the present Mount Royal College and the establishment of a new college board.

4. Agreement requires the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

BILL

An Act respecting the Establishment and Operation of
Mount Royal Junior College

(Assented to _____, 1966)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Mount Royal Junior College Act, 1966*".

2. The Board of Trustees of Calgary School District No. 19 and such other school districts and divisions in and in the vicinity of Calgary that wish to participate therein may, in the manner provided in this Act, establish and operate a public junior college with the name "Mount Royal Junior College".

3. (1) The Board of Trustees of Calgary School District No. 19 and such school districts and divisions in and in the vicinity of Calgary that wish to participate therein may enter into an agreement with the body corporate presently known as the Board of Governors of Mount Royal College to acquire, assume and take over for Mount Royal Junior College the assets, liabilities, facilities, equipment, staff and undertaking presently owned and operated by that body corporate under the name of Mount Royal College.

(2) The agreement shall set out the basis on which the participating boards of trustees are to share the cost of taking over the existing Mount Royal College undertaking and the basis on which they are to share the cost of operation of Mount Royal Junior College.

(3) The agreement may provide that the college board of Mount Royal Junior College shall consist of representatives of the participating boards of trustees and of the body corporate presently known as the Board of Governors of Mount Royal College and shall set out the number of members that the college board is to consist of, their manner of election or appointment, their terms of office and the manner of filling vacancies.

4. An agreement entered into under section 3 and any amendment thereof is of no effect until it is approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

5. Incorporation of Mount Royal Junior College.

6. Application of The Public Junior Colleges Act.

7. Commencement of Act.

5. Upon approving an agreement under section 3 the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall make an order as provided in subsection (3) of section 8 of *The Public Junior Colleges Act* establishing Mount Royal Junior College.

6. (1) The establishment and operation of Mount Royal Junior College shall be governed

(a) by *The Public Junior Colleges Act*, except as otherwise provided in this Act, and

(b) by the agreement and any amendments thereof approved under section 4.

(2) Sections 6 and 7, subsections (1) and (2) of section 8, clause (a) of subsection (3) of section 9, sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 31 of *The Public Junior Colleges Act* do not apply to the establishment or operation of Mount Royal Junior College.

(3) Notwithstanding clause (c) of section 3 of *The Public Junior Colleges Act*, Mount Royal Junior College may teach subjects provided in the high school curriculum of the Province for not more than two academic years after the incorporation of the College.

7. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
