An Act to amend Certain Statutes

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1967)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as *The Tax Exemption Correction Act*.

**2.** (1) Section 1, clause (b), subclause (ii) of chapter 141 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1964 is amended by striking out the figure "13" and by substituting the figure "12".

(2) This section comes into force on the day upon which this Act is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the thirty-first day of December, 1963.

**3.** (1) Section 1 of chapter 129 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1965 is amended by striking out the words and figures "Thirty-two (32)," and by substituting the words and figures "Twenty-two (22),".

(2) This section comes into force on the day upon which this Act is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of January, 1965.

**4.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

## **Explanatory Notes**

This Bill corrects errors in the legal descriptions of the properties belonging to the Governing Council of the Salvation Army (Canada West) and the Tweedsmuir Academic School for Girls and exempted from taxation by chapter 141 of 1964 and chapter 129 of 1965.
