HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Improvement Districts Act, 1965 is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended by adding the word "or" at the end of clause (d) and by adding the following clause after clause (d):

(e) declare any improvement district as an industrial improvement district.

3. Section 36, subsection (1), clause (b) is amended by adding the word "and" at the end of subclause (iii) and by adding the following subclause after subclause (iii):

(iv) in paying over to other municipalities whose area is wholly or partly contained within an industrial improvement district, such portion of the taxes levied and collected for general municipal purposes, as the Minister may by order determine.

4. Section 37 is struck out and the following section is substituted:

37. The Minister may borrow on the security of the revenues of the improvement district or the issuance of debentures, such sums as are required to meet the requirements of the district under this or any other Act.

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1965.

2. Section 4 (d) reads:

 ${\bf 4.}$ The Minister may at any time by order, notice of which shall be published in the Gazette,

(d) alter the name or number of an improvement district.

3. Section 36 (1) (b) reads:

36. (1) The taxes and all other revenues collected in each improvement district \dots

- (b) shall be expended under the direction of the Minister
- (i) in meeting the requirements of the district,
 - (ii) in paying requisitions made under The School Act and The Alberta Hospitals Act, and
- (iii) in paying over to the other Ministers the amounts stated in the estimates submitted to him under section 8, or an equally proportionate part of such amounts if a sum sufficient to discharge all the expenditures of the district is not collected.

4. Section 37 presently reads:

37. The Minister may borrow on the security of the taxes levied by him any sum required for the purpose of paying any requisition due to the board of a school district, a school division, a hospital district or the Province.
