HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Local Authorities Pension Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 6 is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (2):
- (2a) Where a former employee is entitled to a deferred pension and becomes mentally or physically disabled for gainful employment, he may apply for an immediate pension.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 47 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1962.
- 2. Under section 6 a person who leaves the employ of a local authority before retirement may elect to receive a deferred pension when he reaches the age of 60.
