An Act to incorporate Heritage Savings & Trust Company

(Assented to , 1967)

Preamble	<p><b>WHEREAS</b> the persons hereinafter named have by their Petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition:</p> <p>NOW THEREFORE Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:</p>
Short title	<p><b>1.</b> This Act may be cited as <i>The Heritage Savings &amp; Trust Company Act</i>.</p>
Incorporation	<p><b>2.</b> Peter M. Kule, accountant, Walter William Maday, pharmacist, Demitro Melnyk, physician, Zan Roman Matishak, chartered accountant, Peter Savaryn, barrister and solicitor, Mitro Mike Sereda, physician, William Sereda, pharmacist and Peter Nicholas Shewchuk, barrister and solicitor, all of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, together with such persons as become shareholders in the Company, are incorporated under the name of Heritage Savings &amp; Trust Company, hereinafter called "the Company".</p>
Provisional directors	<p><b>3.</b> The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company.</p>
Capital stock	<p><b>4.</b> The capital stock of the Company shall be five million dollars, divided into five hundred thousand shares of ten dollars each.</p>
Head office	<p><b>5.</b> The head office of the Company shall be in the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta.</p>
Powers	<p><b>6.</b> The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of <i>The Trust Companies Act, 1960</i>.</p>
Commencement of Act	<p><b>7.</b> This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.</p>
