An Act to amend The Alberta Government Telephones Act
and to repeal The Telephones Department Act

(Assented to _____, 1968)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Government Telephones Act* is amended
by adding the following heading and section after section 2:

Minister of Telephones

2a. The member of the Executive Council of Alberta
who is appointed for the time being by the Lieutenant Gov-
ernor in Council under the Great Seal of the Province as the
Minister of Telephones is charged with the administration
of this Act.

2. *The Telephones Department Act* is repealed.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it
is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

General: The Bill repeals The Telephones Department Act, chapter 333 of the Revised Statutes, with the result that the Department of Telephones will cease to exist as such. The authority to appoint the Minister of Telephones is being transferred to The Alberta Government Telephones Act, chapter 85 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1958.
