An Act to Repeal certain Statutes

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as The Statutes Repeal Act, 1968.
 - 2. The following enactments are repealed:
 - (a) The Bull Exchange Act, being chapter 34 of the Revised Statutes;
 - (b) The Live Stock Encouragement Act, being chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922;
 - (c) The Live Stock Public Markets Act, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1939;
 - (d) The Pure-bred Bulls Purchase Act, being chapter 17 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1930;
 - (e) The Pure-bred Sire Area Act, being chapter 272 of the Revised Statutes.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Act repeals certain statutes.
- 2. The five Acts listed above are all to be repealed because they are outdated and no longer in use.
