An Act to amend The Mount Royal Junior College Act, 1966

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Mount Royal Junior College Act, 1966 is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 6, subsection (3) is amended by striking out the word "two" and by substituting the word "three".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 60 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1966.
- 2. Section 6 (3) presently reads:

(3) Notwithstanding clause (c) of section 3 of The Public Junior Colleges Act, Mount Royal Junior College may teach subjects provided in the high school curriculum of the Province for not more than two academic years after the incorporation of the College.

This amendment allows the College to continue its program of high school subjects for a further period of one year.
