An Act to amend The Game Act

(*Assented to* , 1968)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Game Act* is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 28, clause (*b*) is amended by adding after the word “scarlet” wherever it occurs the words “or blaze orange”.
- 3.** Section 45, subsection (4) is amended by adding after the word “scarlet” wherever it occurs the words “or blaze orange”.
- 4.** This Act comes in force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 126 of the Revised Statutes.

2. Section 28 presently reads:

28. No person shall hunt or kill any big game

(a) on Sunday, or

(b) unless he is visibly clothed in a long sleeved outer coat or other long sleeved outer garment completely scarlet in colour and a cap or other headdress completely scarlet in colour.

3. Section 45 (4) presently reads:

(4) No person shall hunt any non-migratory game bird in the Green Area of the Province unless he is visibly clothed in a long-sleeved outer coat or other long-sleeved outer garment completely scarlet in colour and a cap or other headdress completely scarlet in colour.
