An Act to amend The Universities Act

(Assented to

, 1968)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Universities Act is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (e) and by substituting the following:
 - (e) "Universities Commission" means The Alberta Universities Commission established by section 62;
- **3.** Section 15, subsection (1) is amended by adding the following clause after clause (b):
 - (b1) to control motor vehicles on university land
 - (i) by parking regulations
 - (A) governing the places where, the times when and the conditions upon which persons are authorized to park or are prohibited to park motor vehicles,
 - (B) authorizing any person or body to allocate reserved parking locations to persons, subject to the conditions prescribed by the regulations,
 - (C) providing for the placement of parking control signs, markings and meters prohibiting or governing the parking of motor vehicles, and
 - (D) providing for the impounding and removal of motor vehicles parked or left in contravention of the regulations,

and

- (ii) by traffic regulations
 - (A) fixing speed limits,
 - (B) prohibiting the entry of or restricting the direction of movement of vehicles, and
 - (C) requiring vehicles to yield or to stop and yield the right of way to other vehicles or pedestrians before proceeding,

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 105 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1966.
- 2. Section 2 (e) presently reads:
 - (e) "Universities Commission" means the body by that name established by section 62;
- **3.** Section 15 (1) (b) reads:
 - 15. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, a board has the management and control of the university and of the property, revenues, business and affairs thereof and in particular but without restricting the generality of the foregoing a board is empowered
 - (b) to make such regulations as to the board seem fit for the management, government and control of the university buildings and lands,

at the places indicated by traffic control devices,

which may delegate to any person or body the authority to determine where the parking control signs, markings and meters or traffic control devices are to be placed and the duty to see that they are so placed and that a record of the locations is kept.

- 4. The following section is added after section 27:
- **27**a. (1) Subject to the approval of the Universities Commission, a board may for the purposes of the university (as defined in section 28) borrow by way of temporary loans from any bank or treasury branch or from any other person such sums of money and upon such terms as the board determines by way of an overdraft or line of credit or by the pledging as security for such temporary loans of notes, bonds, debentures or other securities of the board pending the sale thereof, or in lieu of selling them, or in such other manner as the board determines.
- (2) Any cheques, promissory notes or other instruments that may be necessary or desirable in connection with the borrowing of money and the obtaining of advances by way of a temporary loan under subsection (1) may be executed in such manner as the board determines.
- 5. Section 30a is amended by striking out after the words "and application of sinking funds" the words "or other means of securing the repayment of any loan".
- **6.** Section 62, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the words "Universities Commission" and by substituting the words "The Alberta Universities Commission".
- 7. Section 67 is amended by adding the following subsection:
- (4) Subsection (3) does not apply with respect to the chairman or any officer or employee if he is participating in another pension plan with the approval of the Universities Commission.
- 8. Section 68 is amended by striking out clause (g) and by substituting the following:
 - (g) regulate or prohibit
 - (i) the extension, expansion or establishment of any service, facility or program of study by a university so as to reduce or avoid an undesirable or unnecessary duplication of a similar service, facility or program of study already provided by a university, and
 - (ii) the establishment of a new school or faculty by a university;
- 9. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

4. Authority is given for temporary loans by boards of governors of universities.

5. This amendment corrects a typographical error. The section presently reads:

30a. Subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, a board may provide for the creation, management and application of sinking funds or other means of securing the repayment of any loan or other means of securing the repayment of any loan raised or notes, bonds, debentures or other securities issued by the board, including the redemption by call of any such securities issued subject to redemption in advance of maturity.

6. Section 62 (1) presently reads:

 $\mbox{\bf 62.}$ (1) There is hereby created a corporation with the name of the "Universities Commission".

7. Section 67 (3) reads:

(3) The Public Service Pension Act applies mutatis mutandis to the chairman and the officers and employees of the Commission and each month the Commission shall pay into the General Revenue Fund the contributions required to be made under section 5 of that Act together with an equal amount from the funds of the Commission as its contribution.

8. Section 68 (g) presently reads:

68. The Universities Commission is empowered to

(g) regulate or prohibit the extension, expansion or establishment of any service, facility or program of study by a university so as to reduce or avoid an undesirable or unnecessary duplication of a similar service, facility or program of study already provided by a university;
