An Act to amend The Alberta Wheat Pool Act, 1929

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. This Act may be cited as The Alberta Wheat Pool Act, 1929 amendment Act, 1968.
- 1929, c. 73
- 2. The Alberta Wheat Pool Act, 1929, being chapter 73 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929 is hereby amended.

Amends s. 40
Purchase of reserves from members

- 3. Section 40 is amended by adding the following clause:
  - (f) from members who have been members for such period of time as may be fixed by resolution of the delegates authorizing the purchase;
- Amends s. 48
- **4.** Section 48 is amended by striking out the figures "\$20,000,000.00" and by substituting the figures "\$30,000,-000.00".

Coming into force

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 2. This Bill amends chapter 73 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929.
- 3. A new clause (f) is added to section 40. At present section 40 outlines the various categories of members from which accumulated reserves can be purchased. The new clause (f) creates a new category which would permit purchase of reserves from such category when properly authorized by the Pool delegates.
- 4. The amendment to section 48 is required to increase the reserve structure of Alberta Wheat Pool above its present level of \$20,000,000.00 to \$30,000,000.00. It was felt that such increase was necessary because of increased capital requirements.
