Preamble

WHEREAS John Lawrence Walsh has by his petition represented that he was and is the *de facto* adopted son of Anna Yakemow, deceased, late of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta; and

WHEREAS the said John Lawrence Walsh has by his petition prayed that it be enacted that he be declared to have been and being an adopted *de jure* son of the said deceased as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the said petition;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Presumption of adoption 1. The said John Lawrence Walsh is hereby declared to have been and to now be the adopted son *de jure* of Anna Yakemow, deceased as of and after the 10th day of September, 1919.

Inheritance rights declared 2. The said John Lawrence Walsh is hereby declared to have been and to now be the lawful heir of the said Anna Yakemow and the successor to the estate and property of the said Anna Yakemow, deceased, together with all the rights and privileges set forth in *The Intestate Succession Act*, as if he were a lawfully adopted son of the said deceased pursuant to the laws of the Province of Alberta.

Coming into force

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
