An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act

(Assented to , 1969)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Dairymen's Act is hereby amended.
- **2.** Sections 19, 20 and 21 are struck out and the following sections are substituted:
- 19. The percentage of butterfat in milk supplied to a dairy manufacturing plant shall be determined by either
 - (a) the Babcock test, in which case the measuring pipette used shall have a marked capacity of 17 6/10 cubic centimeters, or
 - (b) any other test approved by the Minister.
- 20. The percentage of butterfat in cream supplied to a dairy manufacturing plant shall be determined by either
 - (a) the Babcock test, in which case the cream placed in the test bottle shall weigh 18 grammes, or
 - (b) any other test approved by the Minister.
 - 21. Where a composite test is made to determine by
 - (a) the Babcock test, or
- (b) any other test approved by the Minister, the percentage of butterfat contained in milk supplied to dairy manufacturing plants by a patron, a sample shall be taken from each weighing and the proportion that each sample bears to the weight of the milk from which it is taken shall be maintained in the taking of all other samples entering into such composite test.
- 3. Section 58 is amended by striking out clause (d) and by substituting the following:
 - (d) over-reads or under-reads either
 - (i) a Babcock test, or
 - (ii) any other test approved by the Minister made for any of the purposes of this Act,
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

This Bill amends chapter 74 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955 as amended for the purpose of authorizing the Minister to approve new tests when he is satisfied that they are satisfactory.
