An Act to amend The Municipal Tax Exemption Act

(Assented to _____, 1969)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Municipal Tax Exemption Act* is hereby amended.
2. The following is added after section 13:
 - 13a. Notwithstanding sections 12 and 13, a municipality may, by by-law,
 - (a) assess land and improvements exempted from assessment and taxation, in whole or in part, under this Act or under a private Act, and
 - (b) levy a tax for all purposes referred to in section 86 of *The Municipal Taxation Act* except those set out in subsection (1), clauses (d), (e), (f) and (g).
3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 61 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1965.

2. The purpose of this amendment is to give municipalities permissive right to assess and tax certain classes of property which heretofore had been exempt from assessment either in whole or in part.
