An Act to amend The Teaching Profession Act

(Assented to _____, 1969)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Teaching Profession Act* is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 6 is amended by striking out subsection (3) and by substituting the following:
 - (3) The association may grant associate membership to any person who meets the conditions prescribed by the by-laws.
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1.** This Bill amends chapter 331 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2.** Associate membership conferred by by-law. Section 6(3) presently reads:

(3) The following teachers are eligible to become associate members by applying personally and by paying the prescribed fee:

- (a) superintendents of schools employed by school boards;
- (b) teachers employed by the Department;
- (c) members of the Faculty of Education of the University of Alberta and teachers engaged in teacher education in any of its affiliated colleges within the Province;
- (d) teachers in provincially operated schools of technology, schools of agriculture, schools for handicapped children or correspondence schools;
- (e) teachers in private schools or kindergartens;
- (f) unemployed teachers;
- (g) teachers pursuing further studies on a full-time basis;
- (h) retired teachers.
