HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Legislative Assembly Act is hereby amended.
- 2. Sections 57 and 58 are struck out.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

- 1. This Bill amends chapter 174 of the Revised Statutes.
- 2. Section 57 is struck out as there is no longer any necessity for the Lieutenant Governor in Council to appoint the Legislative Counsel, since this position is filled under The Public Service Act, 1968.

Section 58 is struck out as it is not necessary for the duties of the Legislative Counsel to be specified in this Act, in view of The Public Service Act, 1968. The duties of the Legislative Counsel are prescribed under The Public Service Act, 1968.
