An Act to amend The Seizures Act

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1969)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Seizures Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 18 is amended by striking out clauses (a) and (b) and by substituting the following:
  - (a) by a sheriff, assistant sheriff, deputy sheriff, sheriff's bailiff or some other person authorized in writing to do so by a sheriff, assistant sheriff or deputy sheriff, and
  - (b) between the hours of 5 o'clock in the morning and 8 o'clock in the afternoon.
3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

## Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 307 of the Revised Statutes.

2. Section 18 presently reads:

18. Unless it is otherwise ordered by a court or judge, no distress shall be made, taken, levied, executed or carried into effect except only

(a) by a sheriff, assistant sheriff, deputy sheriff or sheriff's bailiff,  
or

(b) by some other person authorized in writing to do so by a sheriff,  
an assistant sheriff or a deputy sheriff.

This change sets specific hours for making seizures for distress.
