- ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- 1. This Act may be cited as The Statutes Amendment Act, 1969.
- 2. The Co-operative Marketing Associations Guarantee Act is amended by adding the following section after section 14:
- 15. A lien under this Act may be enforced in the same manner, mutatis mutandis, as is provided in The Mechanics Lien Act, 1960, for the enforcement of a mechanic's lien.
- **3.** The Rural Electrification Long Term Financing Act is amended by adding the following section after section 17:
- 17a. A lien under this Act may be enforced in the same manner, mutatis mutandis, as is provided in The Mechanics Lien Act, 1960, for the enforcement of a mechanic's lien.
- **4.** The Rural Electrification Revolving Fund Act is amended by adding the following section after section 18:
- **18**a. A lien under this Act may be enforced in the same manner, *mutatis mutandis*, as is provided in *The Mechanics Lien Act*, 1960, for the enforcement of a mechanic's lien.
- 5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Act amends The Co-operative Marketing Associations Guarantee Act, The Rural Electrification Revolving Fund Act and The Rural Electrification Long Term Financing Act all for the purpose of prescribing a procedure for enforcing liens given under authority of those Acts.
