Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, J. W. Grant MacEwan, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending the 31st day of March, 1970, and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as *The Appropriation Act No. 1, 1969*.

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding \$280,628,-068.75 towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, 1969 to the 31st day of March, 1970, not otherwise provided for and being the aggregate of

- (a) one-fourth of the amount of the items set forth in the Estimates for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 1970, as laid before the Legislative Assembly at the present session of the Legislature, except Education Department Appropriation 1303, and
- (b) one-half of the amount of the items set forth in Education Department Appropriation 1303 in the Estimates for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 1970, as laid before the Legislative Assembly at the present session of the Legislature.

3. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
