#### An Act to amend The Cultural Development Act, 1967

# (Assented to , 1969)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Cultural Development Act, 1967 is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 5 is amended by striking out the words ", but no such grant or scholarship shall exceed \$10,000 in any one year".

**3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented.

**Explanatory Notes** 

1. This Bill amends chapter 13 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1967.

# 2. Section 5 presently reads:

5. In order to encourage or assist the orderly cultural development of Alberta or of any person or class of persons within Alberta, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may make grants or award scholarships from moneys appropriated by the Legislature, but no such grant or scholarship shall exceed \$10,000 in any one year.
