An Act to amend The Game Act

(Assented to _____, 1969)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Game Act* is hereby amended.
2. Section 2, subsection (1) is amended by striking out clause (s) and by substituting the following:
 - (s) "Green Area" means the lands included in the area outlined and coloured green on the map established by Ministerial Order dated 6th March, 1968 and published in the *Alberta Gazette* on the 15th March, 1968 as amended from time to time;
3. Section 7 is amended by adding at the end of clause (c) the word "or" and by adding the following clause after clause (c):
 - (d) import or control or have possession of any animal or bird, wild by nature, whether native or exotic for the purpose of public performance or display.
4. Section 28 is struck out and the following sections are substituted:
 28. (1) No person shall hunt or kill big game on a Sunday.
 - (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to portions of the Green Area exempted by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under section 126, subsection (1), clause (d1).
 - 28a. No person shall hunt or kill big game unless he is visibly clothed in a long sleeved outer coat or other long sleeved outer garment completely scarlet or blaze orange in colour and a cap or other headdress completely scarlet or blaze orange in colour.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 126 of the Revised Statutes, to provide for Sunday hunting in accordance with a resolution of the Legislative Assembly.

2. Green Area updated.

3. Section 7 reads in part:

7. Unless authorized by a licence or permit issued pursuant to this Act or The Fur Farms Act or the regulations thereunder, no person shall

4. Section 28 presently reads:

28. No person shall hunt or kill any big game

(a) on Sunday, or

(b) unless he is visibly clothed in a long sleeved outer coat or or other long sleeved outer garment completely scarlet or blaze orange in colour and a cap or other headdress completely scarlet or blaze orange in colour.

5. Section 42 is struck out and the following is substituted:

42. (1) No person shall hunt or kill any game bird on a Sunday.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to those portions of the Green Area exempted by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under section 126, subsection (1), clause (d1).

6. Section 126, subsection (1) is amended

(a) by adding the following clause after clause (d) :

(d1) for the areas in which big game or game birds may be hunted and killed in the Green Area pursuant to section 28 or section 42,

(b) by adding the following clause after clause (ff) :

(ff1) for the issue of licences or permits regulating the import, possession and use of animals or birds, wild by nature, whether native or exotic for public performance or display,

7. Section 162, subsection (1), clause (a) is amended by striking out the words "clause (b) of section 28" and by substituting the words "section 28a".

8. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

5. Section 42 presently reads:

42. No person shall hunt any game bird on Sunday.

6. Additional power of the Lieutenant Governor in Council to make regulations.
